She was born in Mũi Né, Phan Thiết in 1973. Her parents then divorced. The elder children, Lâm Bình and Lâm Tuyết Ni followed their dad who had remarried to Saigon. Lâm Mỹ Việt and Lâm Mỹ Linh stayed with their mother in Mũi Né.

Her mother passed away when Mỹ Việt was four years of age. Lâm Bình, 13 returned from Saigon to Mũi Né to raise and care for his two young sisters. When Bình was 18, he escaped abroad with sisters Mỹ Việt 11 and Mỹ Linh 14.

They arrived to the U.S. in 1985 and were sponsored by a couple in MI. Mỹ Việt became an internist working for Kaiser, San Rafel in 2006. Mỹ Linh is an anesthesiologist.

In 2008, she was diagnosed with blood cancer and became a patient at Kaiser. She was treated with chemotherapy for two years and now needed marrow transplant.
